Who are China's 5G operators?

Chinese main operators are China Mobile, China Telecom and China Unicom. In addition to its expected expansion in the 5G field, China noted that it is also set to begin trials for 10-gigabit optical networks and enhance computing power infrastructure, reflecting the growing demand for artificial intelligence (AI) technologies.

Kenya has no regulations that restrict the use of Chinese technology for 5G. In fact, in 2022, CAK signed a memorandum of understanding with Chinese technology giant Huawei ...

Full 5G access will require close collaboration with the Communications Authority of Kenya and the three telcos. Trainings and workshops on its use will be required.
