The telecommunications market is dominated by three large mobile operators- GrameePhone, Robi and Banglalink - with mobile-only infrastructure competing with the incumbent Bangladesh Telecommunications Company Limited (BTCL) which also operates Teletalk the smallest mobile operator in the country.
